Additional Benefits:

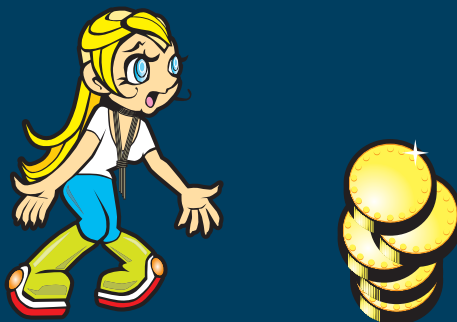
Citizens Advice and Northern Bank staff are available to deliver a free one-hour talk in schools and youth settings.
